
Voices for Children Advocacy Center is a safe place for children to talk.

A staff member will walk with you up this hallway




And through this doorway into our Lobby.




Our Lobby is a safe place. You can play with toys, watch T.V. and read books while you wait.



The Lobby has a window with a bell. If you have any questions you can ring the bell.




An adult will come to the Lobby through this door and walk with you right across the hall.




Across the hall they will take you through this door.




Inside the door is a safe room where you get to talk to an adult by yourself. This is called an interview.

When they are finished an adult will walk with you back out to the front door and say goodbye.
