This is the parking lot where you will  
park your car.



This is the door you will use to enter the building. You are entering a safe place.

Press this button when you get to the door. You will hear a voice asking how they can help you.

Someone will come to meet you at the door.

You are entering a safe place.







You will walk through the door into the front of the house.



Then you will walk through this door...





You will walk into the family room. In this room there are toys, books, and a t.v.  
The Family room is a safe place.



You will sit in the family room with the adult that brought you here. The Family Room is a safe space.



Sometimes when you come to talk, Daphne will be there, too. If Daphne is there she will greet you in the Family Room.





An adult from Voices for Children will come to meet you in the family room. Then they will take you up these stairs.



Then, they will take you through this door.

You will go into this room.  
This is where you will get  
to talk to an adult.  
You will talk to the adult  
by yourself.  
This is called an interview.





The adult will get to know you, ask some questions and listen to you.

You can also ask the adult questions.

It is important to tell the truth.

The room is a safe place.





You might play again in the family room after your interview. The adults might talk in a different room. The family room is a safe place.

The adults at Voices for Children will say good-bye. You will leave with the adult you came with.
